

Your gull-proof bag

This is a seagull-proof bag to hold your black sacks of rubbish on your fortnightly collection day. This bag will:

- Protect your rubbish from seagulls and other vermin
- Reduce the amount of litter on your street
- Be easy to use and store between collections



There is no charge for this bag, which remains the property of Somerset Waste Partnership and cannot be sold, given away or exchanged. If moving, leave the bag behind with other waste containers.

If the bag is no longer required, contact Sedgemoor District Council customer services to arrange its collection: customer.services@sedgemoor.gov.uk or 0300 303 7803.

It will hold three to four black sacks of rubbish. Do not use it for loose rubbish or for recycling. Put the black sacks of rubbish in the bag, close the top and place it out for collection by 7am as usual and no earlier than the night before, attached to a suitable object. Take the bag back in as soon as possible and store safely until your next collection. Rubbish put out on the wrong dates is not collected.

Your gull-proof bag

Take the bag back in as soon as possible and store safely until your next collection. Rubbish put out on the wrong dates is not collected.
